


Disaster Background

- In 2022–23, Pakistan faced devastating floods.
- Millions were affected lives lost, homes destroyed, and infrastructure damaged.
- Sindh was the most affected province.
- Urgent need for rehabilitation and sustainable recovery was arranged



- Extremely poor, flood-affected families.
- Living in unsafe temporary tents.
- Recommended by District Committee members.
- Nearby Rotary Clubs available to lead and support.
- Community showed interest and contributed labor in construction.





Project Scope – Infrastructure: A support by Rotary Germany:

For 100 families:

- Permanent housing units
- Eco-toilets
- Hand pumps for clean water
- Solar Panels for energy
- School, Health Center & Community Center

Design Aspects Considered

- Sustainable construction using mud, lime and bamboo
- Height of earth embankment determined by the flooding records of previous years
- Create drainage channels connected to nearby water bodies to prevent stagnation of water
- Planting water resistant plants/trees to protect houses from erosion






